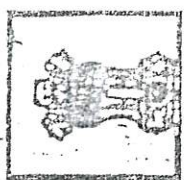

BIJAPUR. BYE-LAWS

1 The Association shall be named "The Djjapur Liberal Dist. Educational Association" and is already registered under the Act XXI of 1860.

2 The objects of the Association are; (a) Advancement of education in the district, in general, technical, commercial agricultural and such other subjects, by establishing scholarships, lodging & boarding houses, schools & colleges, workshops or by such other means as may be resolved from time to time by the Association.

(b) Promotion of religious, social, sanitary, agricultural or other, scientific or general literature by awarding prizes or scholarships or by founding libraries, magazines or newspapers or by organizing lectures or by such other means or as may be resolved upon by the Association from time to time.

3 The activities of the Association shall extend to the whole of Bijapur District with its office in the city of Bijapur.

(b) No person shall be a member of the Association unless admitted by special resolution of the Governing Body. His name shall be proposed or seconded by the members of the Association.

(c) No person shall have the right to vote or take part in the proceedings of the General Body, or shall be elected on the Governing Body unless he has been admitted as a member before the end of the previous calendar year.

(d) All these are recognised as members of the Association and duly entered in the register of members shall form the General committee.

(e) A member will acquire the right to take part and vote in the general committee, only after a period of one year after being admitted as a member by resolution of the General Body. But this rule will not apply in the case of donors, patrons, etc; who have paid the moeny in the year 1944 or before.

Office Bearers

- 8 The Association shall have.
 - (i) a President.
 - (ii) a Vice-President or Vice-Presidents.
 - (iii) a General Secretary.
 - (iv) a Governing Body.

9 The General Body may appoint besides a Governing Sub-committees from amongst the members of the Association consisting of not less than 7 members wherever and

whenever necessary to transact, to perform or to supervise any specific work assigned to them by the Association. Such sub-committees shall perform, transact or function under the supervision, guidance and control of the Governing Body. The General Body may fix the duration of the period of above mentioned sub-committees which shall not exceed 3 years.

10 The Association may also appoint Joint Secretary who may be an honorary or Paid Officer. The General Secretary shall be an ex-officio member of the Governing Body. The Principals of the Arts and Science Colleges, if started by the Association shall be ex-officio members of the Governing Body.

11 The Governing Body shall consist of not more than twelve members and not less than seven members who shall be elected by the General Body in the general Meeting and some of them may be co-opted from amongst the members under Bye-Law No. 4.

12 The President, the Vice-President, the General Secretary and the Governing Body shall be elected by the General Body and shall hold office for not less than Five years or till the date of election.

Note: Bye laws No. 12 is amended as per resolution No. 3 of the General Body Meeting held in 6-12-1987.

Meeting General Body

13 The General Body shall ordinarily meet once in every year in the month of April, or May at a place and time notified by the President which meeting shall be deemed as the Annual General Meeting of the general body.

14 The President whenever he thinks fit and shall, upon written request of the Governing Body, or 250 members or members of the Association stating any motion or proposition

call a special meeting within a month from the receipt of such a request.

Note: Bye Law No. 14 is amended as per Resolution No. 3 of the General Body Meeting held on 6-12-1987.

15 Notice of 15 clear days of an ordinary general meeting and notice of ten clear days of a special general meeting specifying time and place at which the meeting is to be held and the business to be transacted there at shall be given to the members and posted at the office of the Association. The said notice shall include any motion or proposition mentioned in the written request made for such meeting.

16 Every General Meeting shall be presided over by the President or if he be absent by the Vice-President or if both be absent, by such one of the members present as may be chosen by the meeting to be the Chairman for the occasion.

17 All questions shall be decided by majority of votes of members present. In case of the equality of votes the presiding authority shall have a casting vote which he shall exercise.

18 No business shall be transacted at any general meeting unless 20 members at least are present at any time from the beginning to the end thereof. When there is no quorum the presiding authority shall adjourn the meeting and no quorum shall be required for transaction of a business at such adjourned meeting.

19 Any General Meeting for reasons to be recorded may be adjourned from time to time.

20 No resolution of the general body shall be altered, modified or changed by the succeeding general committee unless a period of six months has elapsed after the passing of the first resolution and 3/4th of the members present at the next meeting are for it.

Business of the General Meetings.

- 21(A) At the Annual General Meeting the following shall be transacted:-
 - (a) Consideration of the report of the work done during the previous year.
 - (b) Consideration of the statement of accounts of the preceding year duly audited.
 - (c) Adoption of the Budget for the succeeding year.
 - (d) Election of the Governing Body, Sub-Committees and also of the General Secretary and Co-optation of experts in education on the Governing Body whenever necessary.
 - (e) Appointment of Treasurer.
 - (f) Appointment of an Auditor.
 - (g) Any other business mentioned in the agenda or laid before a meeting with the permission of the presiding authority at the commencement of the meeting.
- 21(B) The Governing Body may elect either the President or the Vice-President of the Association or any member of the Governing Body as the Chairman of the Governing Body.

Meeting of the Governing Body.

22 The Governing Body shall meet at least once in three months and may adjourn as it thinks proper but the Chairman whenever he thinks fit may and shall, upon the request of not less than three members of the Governing Body on a date not more than seven days after the presentation of such a request.

23 Notice of 7 clear days shall be given for a meeting of the Governing Body.

24 No business shall be transacted at a meeting of the Governing Body unless not less than 1/3 members of the Governing Body are present thereat throughout.

25 Every meeting of the Governing Body shall be presided over by the Chairman of the Governing Body or by the Vice-Chairman or if both of them be absent, by the Chairman elected by the meeting for the occasion from amongst the members present.

26 All questions shall be decided by a majority of votes of members present and in case of equality of votes the Chairman of the meeting shall have a casting vote which shall be exercised. In case the Chairman refuses to exercise his casting vote the consideration of the proposition about which votes are taken shall be deemed to have been adjourned.

27 The Chairman of the Governing Body whenever he thinks it proper to do so, instead of convening meeting, circulate a written proposition of his own or any other member of the Association or any other executive officer of the Association for the observation of the Governing Body.

28 The decision of any proposition so circulated shall be upon it unless a special meeting is convened to consider the proposition.

29 Every decision arrived at under Bye-law No. 27 shall be recorded in the proceeding book kept by the Governing Body.

Powers and Functions of the President

30 The President shall:-

- (a) Preside over the General or special committee meetings.
- (b) Call General or Special committee meeting whenever necessary.
- (c) Carry out and give effect to the resolution or resolutions of the Governing Body of the Association in the manner specified by it.

(b) The funds of the Association may be invested in any aforesaid manner either in the name of the President, Chairman of the Governing Body or in the name of the General Secretary as may be decided by the Governing Body from time to time.

(d) to recover all donations, subscriptions and other moneys payable to the Association and to credit the same to the account of the Association.

48 Every suit for and on behalf of the Association shall be filed or defended with the previous approval of the Governing Body. The General Secretary shall represent the Association in all suitable suits.

49 Every office bearer of the Association shall hold the office to which he is elected till his successor is elected by the Governing Body duly authorised in this behalf.

50 All the account books and minute books of the General Committee, the Governing Body and other sub-committees shall be opened to inspection in the office of the Association during office hours.

51 No Act of the Association or of the Managing Committee shall be deemed to be invalid by reasons only of some defects in the appointment of the President or any member of the Governing Body.

52 These bye-laws may be amended or varied or decided by a special resolution duly passed at the General Meeting of the Association by a majority of at least 2/3rd present and when there is a quorum.

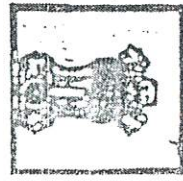

- (b) Consideration of the statement of accounts of the preceding year duly audited.
- (c) Adoption of the Budget for the succeeding year.
- (d) Election of the Governing Body, Sub-Committees and also of the General Secretary and Co-optation of experts in education on the Governing Body whenever necessary.
- (e) Appointment of Treasurer.
- (f) Appointment of an Auditor.

(g) Any other business mentioned in the agenda or laid before a meeting with the permission of the presiding authority at the commencement of the meeting.

21(B) The General Body may elect either the President or the Vice-President of the Association or any member of the Governing Body as the Chairman of the Governing Body.

Meeting of the Governing Body.

22 The Governing Body shall meet at least once in three months and may adjourn as it thinks proper, but the Chairman whenever he thinks fit may and shall, upon the request of not less than three members of the Governing Body on a date not more than seven days after the presentation of such a request.

23 Notice of 7 clear days shall be given for a meeting of the Governing Body.

24 No business shall be transacted at a meeting of the Governing Body unless not less than 1/3 members of the Governing Body are present thereat through whom the Association's

25 Every meeting of the Governing Body shall be presided over by the Chairman of the Governing Body or by the Vice-Chairman or if both of them be absent, by the Chairman elected by the meeting for the occasion from amongst the members present.
